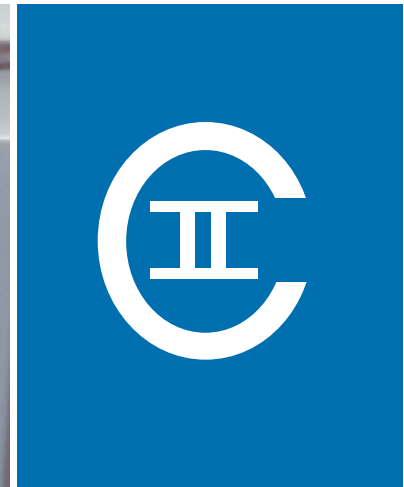
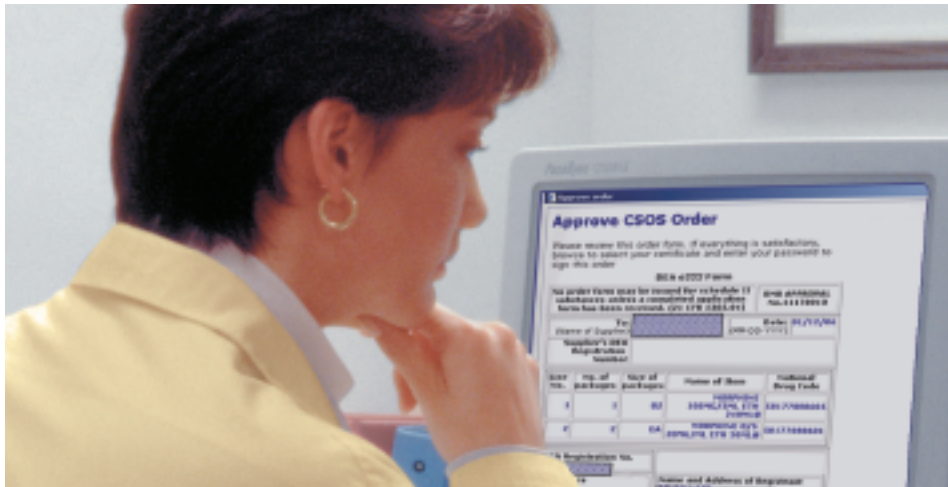

| Paper blanks must be filled out manually | Orders are created using your standard process through your pharmacy system or Supply Management Online |
| Paper blanks must be signed with a pen by an authorized signer | Orders are signed electronically using a password-protected digital certificate |
| Paper blanks are sent to McKesson via courier — missing order cutoff time could result in a replenishment delay of up to two days | Orders are signed and sent electronically in seconds |
| Substitutions are handled manually both in the pharmacy and distribution center | Substitutions are handled online, consistent with policies already in place for your account |
